

Mondaine Savonnette 2011



The pocket watch has been making a comeback over the last couple of years, taking the timepiece off the wrist and putting it back in the pocket. Mondaine has had a pocket watch in its line for many years, and for 2011, Mondaine is launching a new generation of the Savonnette pocket watch.

The new style has a rounded, smoother shape with no sharp edges to be found. Savonnette means "little soap" in French, and the shape reminds you of a smooth bar of luxurious soap.

There's something about a pocket watch to make you think of times gone by. You could be wearing a trench coat and standing in the Zurich train station on a rainy night during the 1940s, but the Savonnette just as easily fits in today's fast paced world – the new design is both traditional and modern at the same time.

The Savonnette features the famous Swiss Railway clock design, white with thick, raised black hour markers, with black hour and minutes hands, and of course the signature Swiss Railways red second hand with the ball on the end. The cover of the stainless steel 50 mm Savonnette is tightly integrated into the case, and a press of the crown opens the timepiece, while it snaps closed with a confident click. This elegant and distinctive pocket watch comes in a red leather pouch.

Feeling traditional or trendy? Think about the new Savonnette, which honors the storied past of watch making and the railroads, but is aimed squarely at the future.

Available at authorized, professional watch dealers, accompanied by a two-year warranty and backed by the Mondaine International Service Network (MISO), recommended public price is CHF 295.–
